Awards: Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd, medals for all players. The winning player will be the Kansas State Representative to the National Girls Invitational Tournament

USCF and an unrated section for the parents and friends, if enough entries are made: For those traveling with the girls, please come play in a side tournaments, which will start at 9:15 AM. Time control will be G/60 d5. Pre-registration is not needed

Directions: From Salina: I-135 South to Exit #78 (Lindsborg); turn right 4.4 miles on Old Hwy 81 to Lincoln Street; turn right 1.0 mile on Lincoln Street to Coronado Road/13th Ave; turn right about 2 blocks on Coronado Road/13th Ave to Smoky Valley High School on right

From Wichita: I-135 North to Exit #72 (Lindsborg); turn left 2.5 miles on Smoky Valley Road to Old Hwy 81; turn right 1.5 miles on Old Hwy 81 to Lincoln Street; turn left 1.0 mile on Lincoln Street to Coronado Road/13th Ave; turn right about 2 blocks on Coronado Road/13th Ave to Smoky Valley High School on right
